


LARGE AREA MAINTENANCE SHELTER (LAMS) PROGRAM BRIEFED AT JOINT COMMITTEE ON TACTICAL SHELTERS (JOCOTAS) SPRING MEETING. On 19 May 2015 the TACOM Integrated Logistics Support Center (ILSC) lead for LAMS and Force Provider presented the 2015 support concept for the maintenance shelter project. The LAMS system is a War Reserve asset dating back to 1991 and Operation Desert Storm. Over 500 of the shelters were procured since the project initiation however it is an anomaly because

it is not a formal Army Program of Record. As a result there is no Product Manager involved and no institutional plan for long term sustainment. NSRDEC and TACOM had teamed to fill the gap since 1999. In 2013 NSRDEC formally separated from the program to concentrate on Science and Technology efforts and the ILSC restructured to meet the new requirement. The intent of the effort is to establish a new internal LAMS team and set up



procurement vehicles to acquire; shelters, spare parts and services. They established a forward LAMS ARCENT support office in Arfijan to maintain 50 shelters in place and erect 16 more shelters to enable Operation Inherent Resolve (OIR) missions. OIR is focused on targeted airstrikes against ISIL terrorists in Iraq and Syria. LAMS are used in staging and aircraft maintenance. See full map on website for additional info.
