# Base History



- 1945 - Commissioned as a Naval base - Primary mission was mine countermeasures R&D
- 1955-1992 - Numerous name changes and reorganizations
- 1992 - Base aligned under NAVSEA, Naval Surface Warfare Center
- 2003 - Naval Support Activity Panama City established under Commander Navy Installations Command (CNIC)

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



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
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# NDSTC


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# Navy Experimental Diving Unit

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# DJC2



- A standardized, integrated, rapidly deployable, modular, scalable Joint command and control
- Deployable Joint Command and Control (DJC2) improves the ability of Joint Task Force/Joint Force Commanders to provide C2 functions by fielding scalable, deployable command centers that equip them with networks, tested C2 applications and collaboration tools


**DJC2 Spiral 1.2 Core System**
