


Force Provider Expeditionary Capability Production Document (FPE CPD) Briefing.

The Capability Developments Team Leader from the United States Army Combined Arms Support Command (USA CASCOM) at Fort Lee, VA, presented the capabilities included in the 27 Feb 14 approved FPE CPD. This included identification of the various configurations: 150 person module based on Triple Containers (TriCons) and air structure tents; and the directed 50/75 person configuration. Included in this were the capabilities of the subsystems, add-on capabilities for both 150 person modules when operating independently and when collocated (supporting 600 or more personnel). Also identified were the



approved requirements for future add-on capabilities such as Expeditionary Water Packaging (water bottling), Ice Production, Solid Waste Disposal (incineration) and waste to energy. Finally he noted that the objective capability for a 150 person rigid wall modules was recently agreed to at the Quartermaster Board of Directors and that it would be incorporated through attrition (replacement of washed out modules) for up to 10% (24 modules) and provided an example of how these could be laid out. Noted was the fact that Rigid Wall modules can be stacked. The briefing is approved for public release as the FPE CPD has been approved and the is authorized for release.
