

**NAVY MOBILE MAINTENANCE FACILITIES (MMF) PROGRAM BRIEFED AT THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON TACTICAL SHELTERS (JOCOTAS) MEETING.** On 18 Nov 2014 the Deputy Program Manager

for the Navy MMF mission provided the JOCOTAS community an overview of their shelter program that supports Naval Air (NAVAIR) operations. MMF provides design, build and integration services for the Navy shelter community, delivers life cycle logistics support for integrated shelters and engineering support to assist Navy users worldwide. They are responsible for acquisition



of shelters, environmental control units and expeditionary power; manage shelter and tactical quiet generator rework programs, and develop new standard system configurations. MMF's are forward deployed worldwide from both, land based and ship board locations and execute



missions that include aircraft and helicopter avionics support, expeditionary supply support, battery maintenance and parts preparation capabilities. The MMF consists of a Family of seven, 20' long ISO Standard NAVAIR Mobile Shelters that can be interconnected end to end, end to side, side to side and through a six shelter integration unit.
