

A TRANSFORMATIVE REDUCTIONS IN OPERATIONAL ENERGY CONSUMPTION (TROPEC) PROGRAM UPDATE was briefed at the 19 Nov 2015 JOCOTAS meeting at NSRDEC. Led by USPACOM, TROPEC is an expeditionary energy technology identification, assessment, and transition program focused entirely on applications in tropical environments (the USPACOM AOR) and their unique challenges. In addition to overviewing these challenges, the TROPEC assessment process, and camp energy end-use target areas, the briefing touched on a few key opportunity areas and more specifically on the sizeable opportunities demonstrated by integrating key solutions in the ECU and shelter areas. The briefing also outlined the multiple venues utilized and available for live (using soldiers/marines) field technology assessments. TROPEC partners with multiple military expeditionary stakeholders for successful field assessments and continues to offer up to 50% cost share in these assessments.
